### Results:

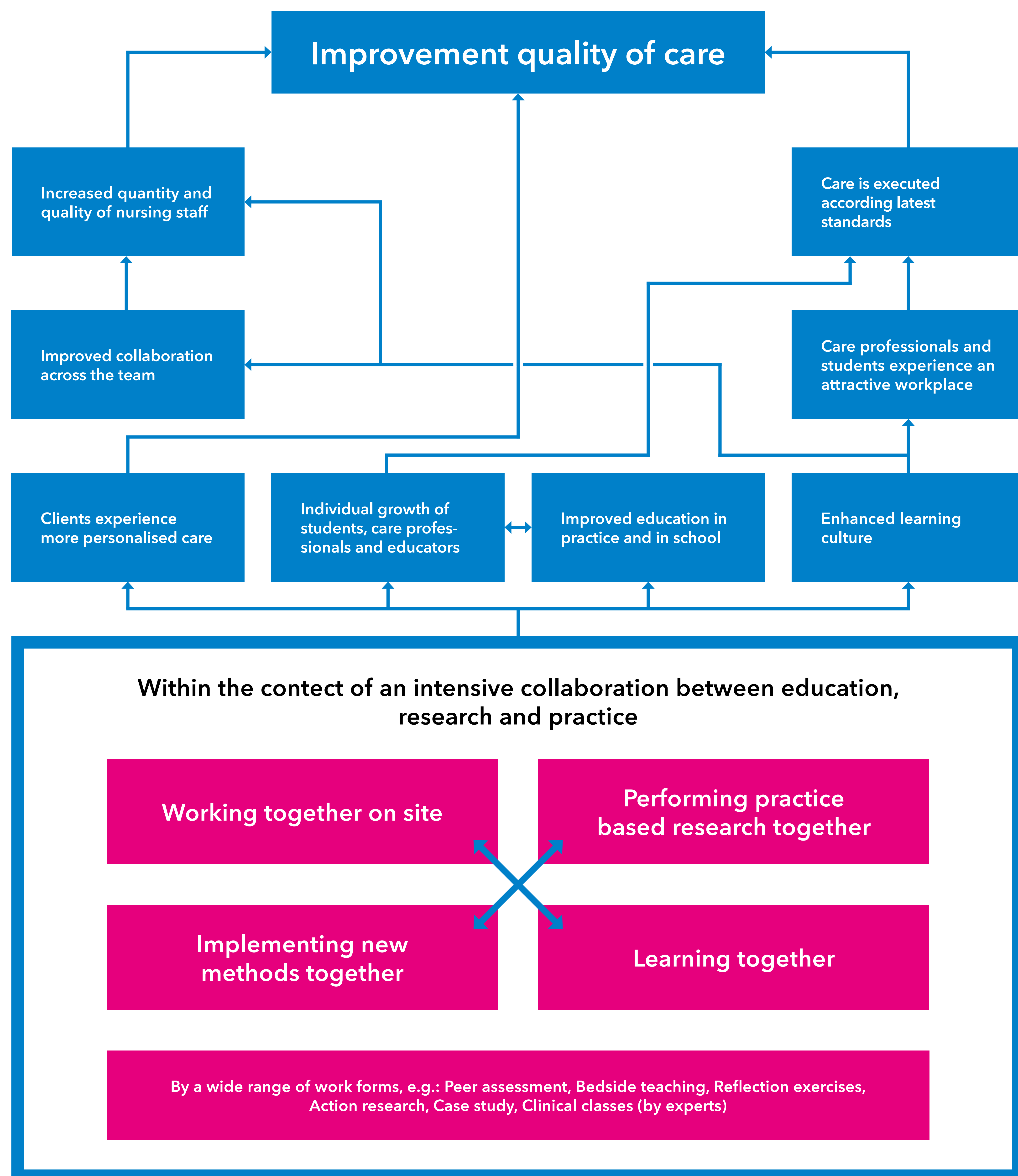
