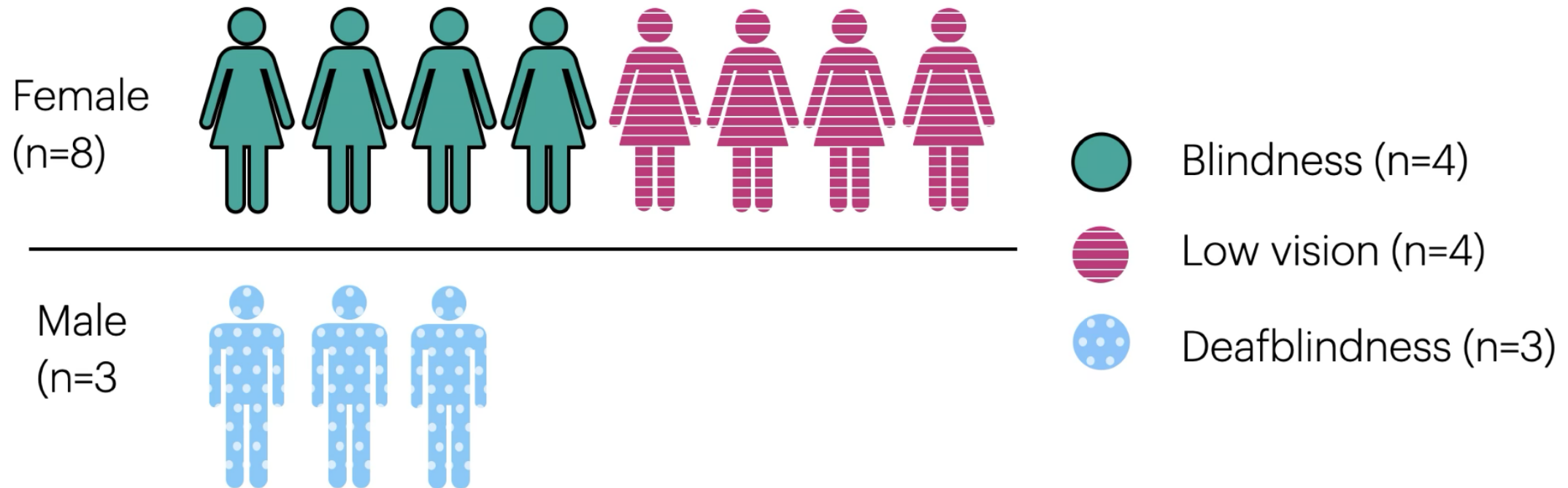

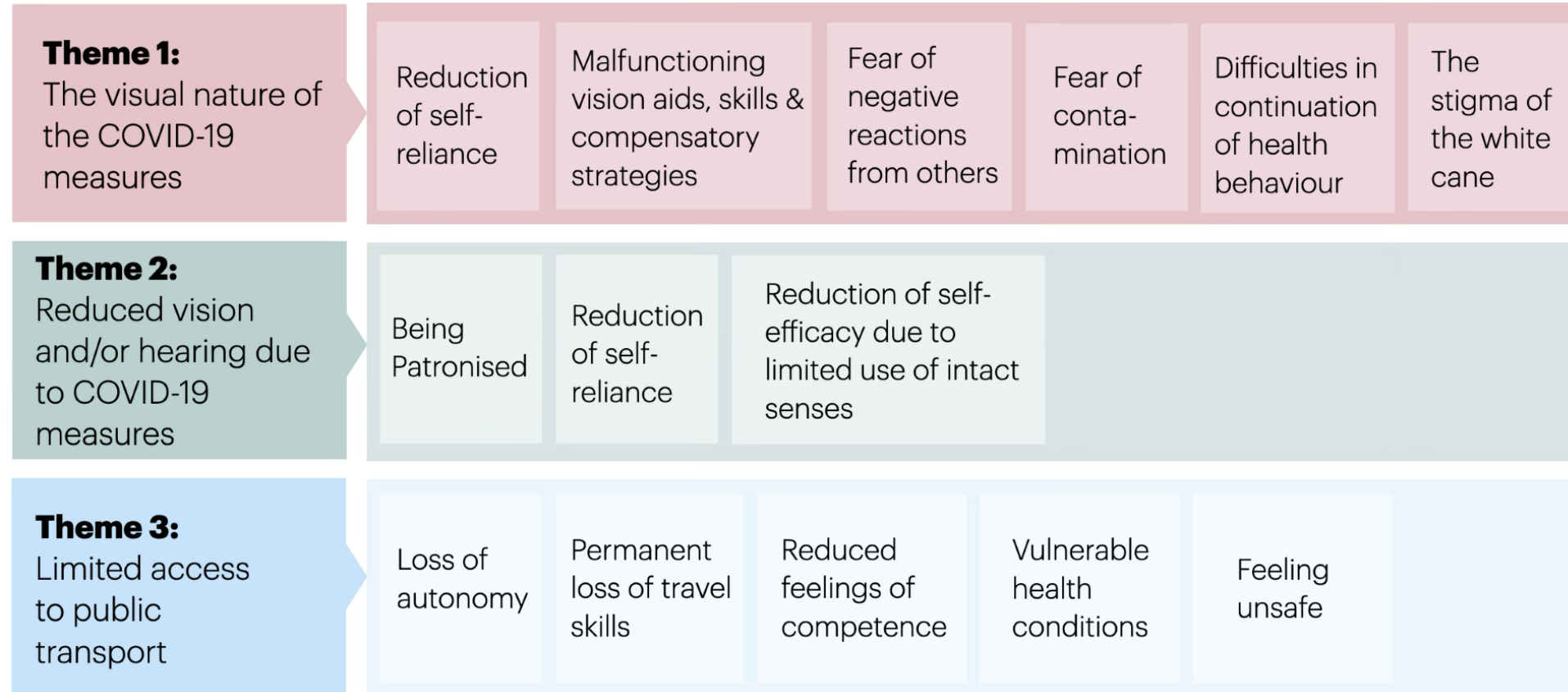

The impact of the COVID-19 measures on the psychosocial well-being of people with a visual impairment or deafblindness (VIDB)

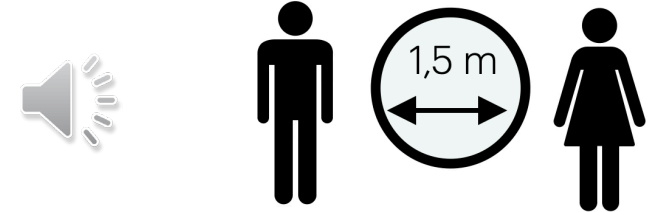

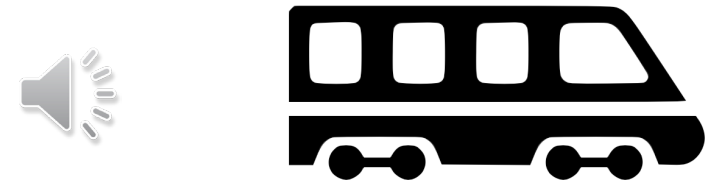
1. The visual nature of the COVID-19 measures



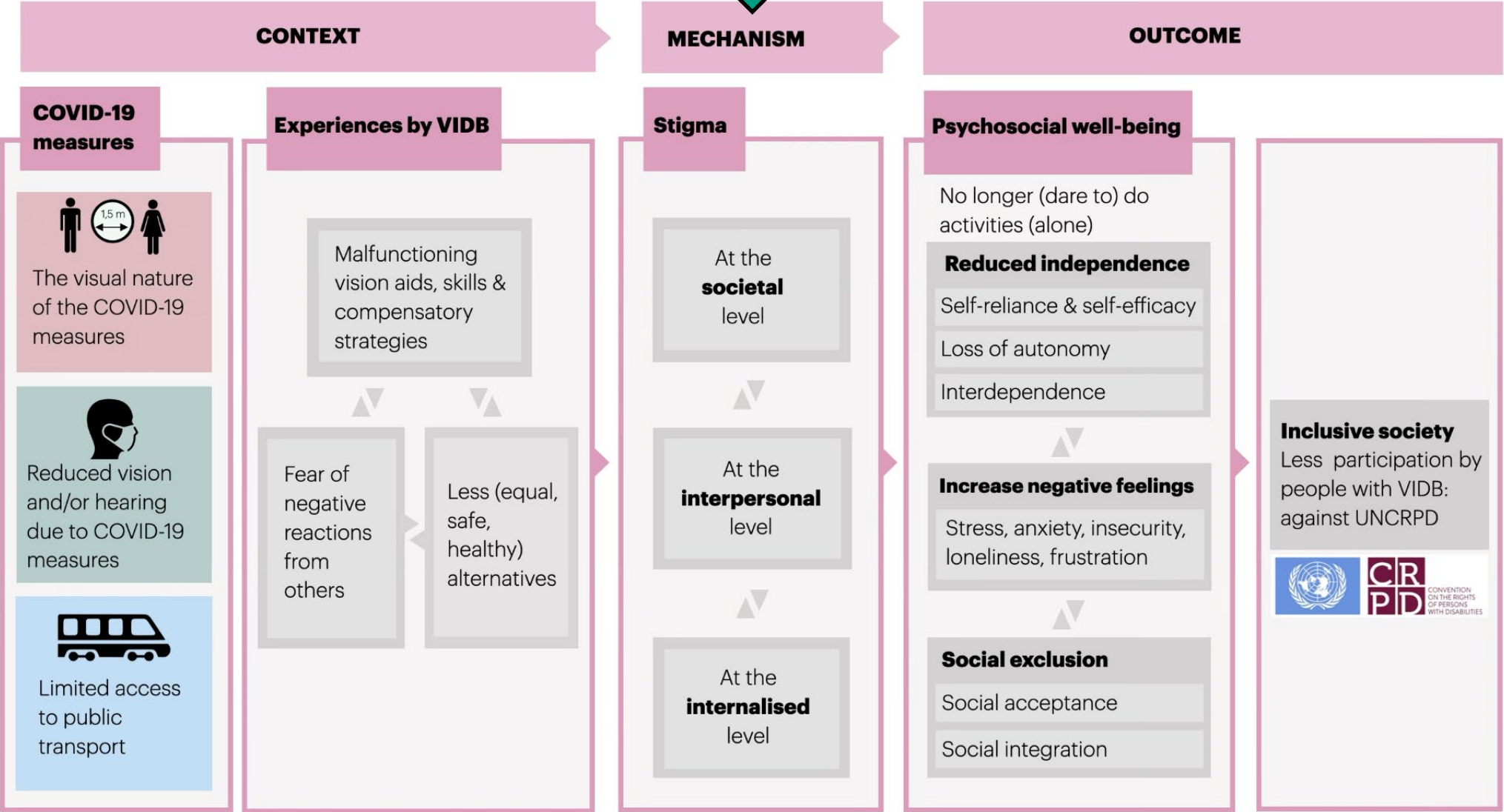
2. Reduced vision and/or hearing due to the COVID-19 measures



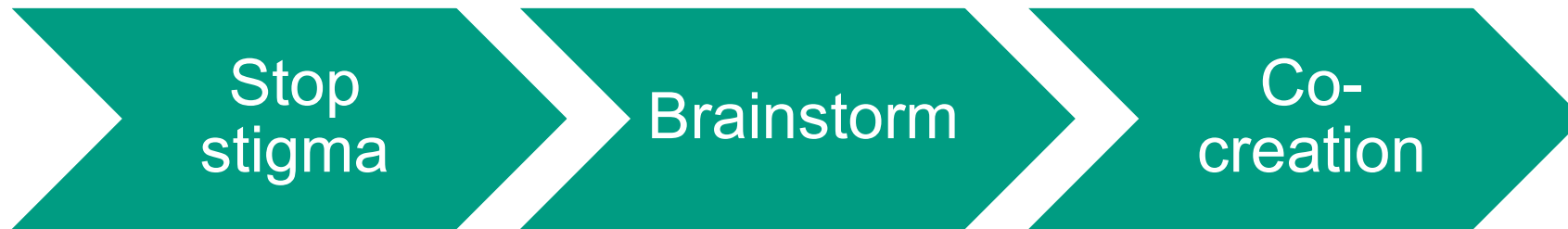
3. Limited access to public transport
